# **Student Travel Bursary Application Guidelines (2023)**

# Purpose:

The CAPT Student Travel Award is offered to graduate or post-doctoral students. It is intended to defray the travel costs (entirely or in part) associated with making a scientific presentation as a first author or presenter at the CAPT Annual Conference.

# **Eligibility Criteria:**

Graduate and post-doctoral students are eligible to apply if

- The student is currently enrolled full-time at a recognized institution, with priority given to students studying in Canada
- The student is the first author or presenter of a minimum of one abstract which was accepted for presentation at the CAPT Annual Conference

Students will be granted a travel bursary of a maximum of \$1,500 for a total of \$10,,000.

Please note that eligibility and/or abstract acceptance does not guarantee receipt of an award.
