Every 4 months, CAPT will highlight and disseminate recently published research articles authored by our trainees. All submitted articles will be reviewed by the Scientific Planning Committee to ensure the robustness of the publication and that it aligns with CAPT mission and vision.

Eligibility criteria:

- 1. The CAPT trainee (Undergraduate students, graduate students, post-doctoral fellows) must be the leading author.
- 2. The article must be relevant to population therapeutics, this includes a wide range of research area, including but not limited to: epidemiology, economics and policy decision-making across a number of disease strands and unique stakeholder interests.
- 3. The article must be recently published (within previous 4 months) or in-press.
- 4. Research articles only. Commentaries, editorials, opinion pieces, and book chapters are not eligible.
- 5. The submission must be approved by the trainee's supervisor and the corresponding author.
- 6. No specific deadlines for submission. Approved articles will be disseminated in the following cycle with up to 5 articles in each cycle.
